## **ET working assumptions**

E.g. According to ESFRI application is ET a single site observatory with a Headquarter and datacenter. However, multiple site configurations are being discussed within the ET organisation and ET Collaboration.

- Parallel developments in the ET project of the future ET organisation: instrument-design, procurement model, financial model, HR model
- > Later on: possible revision or adjustement of assumptions
- ➤ This might have an impact on the preferred legal model preferred → Legal Structure follows function

Considerations for request:

- preliminary state of discussion in BGR  $\rightarrow$  consensus on a preferred legal framework not before Q2 25
- experience from other large scale research infrastructures with regard to the length of negotiation process

Possible options discussed in October 24 (Midterm review):

- Extension of the deadline until M47 and
- Content change: draft legal documents and content for draft statutes.

**Extension until M47**; with the note that a request for a content change may be needed in the future, depending on how discussions progress in terms of the geometry, site selection and legal framework.

#### Risks

- Extension of decision making timelines with an impact on the governance: Instrument-design, procurement model, site selection, funding model
- > WP2 depends on the input from BGR (ET decision making body), if the input for the long term and/or intermediate entity is not timely exchanged:
  - WP2 is unable to deliver the legal documents (Del.2.3.) within the ETPP project timeline
  - The level of accuracy of the Roadmap to establish the final legal entity (Del.2.4.) might be low

### **Risk Mitigation**

- Increased interaction with BGR, direct link to BGR secretary, invitation to WP2 meeting
- Initiation of (in-person) workshops to facilitate informative discussions: BGR experts, ETO, ETPP
- Interaction with the other ETPP workpackages (WP3,WP7) to define relevant aspects (e.g. financial model and procurement strategy)
- Interaction with BGR experts on specific items

## WP 2: some take aways 9-10 April 2025

- Willingness to build the bridge → "defining both sites of the riverbank": funding timelines and ETO project timeline
- o BGR will work towards a consensus on a preferred legal entity: flexibility
- o HR scheme: competitive salaries with industry first phase focus on technicians and engineers
- o Fair return\*: apply a fair return principle to attract Founding Members
- IKC: one central procurement office is recommended
- Multi site configuration: one central organisation is recommended
- Intermediate legal entity: dedicated entity for preparation ET project with defined purpose and scope to prepare for final legal entity and construction





\*boundary condition: consensus on preferred final legal entity, clarity on geometry and configuration
