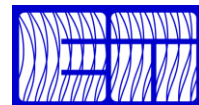


# National and International events

# 1. Introduction

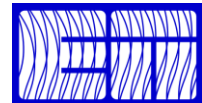
- One of the aspects of the industry engagement plan is to feature the ET in existing Big Science national and international events.
- ET-PP is collaborating with a network of European ILOs for Big Science RIs, mainly CERN but also the ITER project, synchrotrons, etc.
- We have 26 ILOs from 17 countries in our list.
- Task 7.2 regularly sends out newsletters to the ILO list.
- We have offered all ILOs to coordinate the presence of ET in their nationally organised events.

# 1. Past events since last meeting

- The main event was **BSBF2024** in (Trieste, 1-4 October 2024)
- Included talks by INAF/INFN President and Nikhef's outgoing director
- 1300 delegates from over 500 organizations across 32 countries
- 245 exhibitions, 14 national pavillions



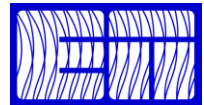

## 2. Other events during the last year

- **Einstein Telescope webinar (25 June, 2025).** Organised by ET EMR. Focused on developments surrounding the Einstein Telescope and heard more about the opportunities for companies from Belgium, Germany and the Netherlands
- **Industrial Opportunity Days (Turin, 12-13 June).** One of the presentations during the IOD event was dedicated to Einstein Telescope and included an update to businesses on the status of the project and prospects for industrial involvement.
- **IUVSTA workshop 102: Ultra Clean Vacuum (Delft, February 3 – 6 2025).** Included discussions about the challenges related to the stringent ET vacuum requirements for the beam pipe and mirrors operating at cryogenic temperatures
- **Einstein Telescope Project Seminar (Turin, 11 December 2024).** The event focused on Italy's proposal to host the site in Sardinia and also included discussions on the procurement process and the involvement of Italian companies in the construction and technological development of the infrastructure.
